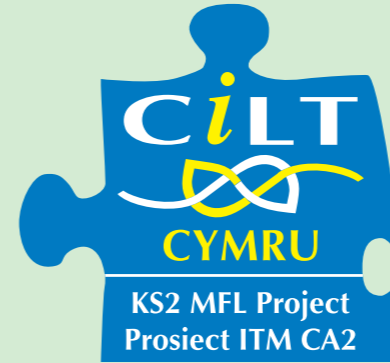

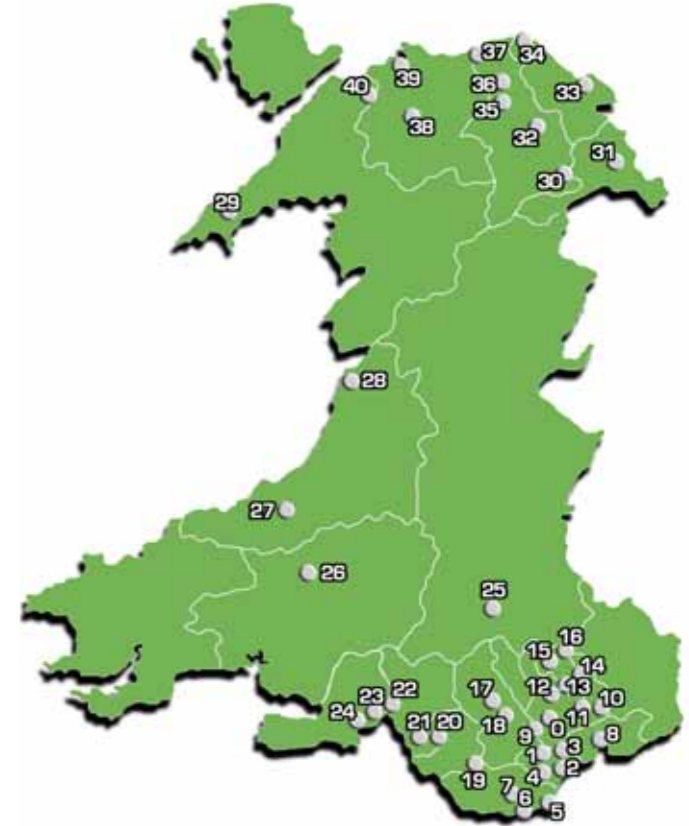


A Pilot Programme for Modern Foreign Languages in Primary Schools in Wales

Rhaglen Beilot ar gyfer Ieithoedd Tramor Modern mewn Ysgolion Cynradd yng Nghymru.

Who is involved in the KS2 Project?

The Project involves 22 secondary schools across Wales and the 105 Primary schools that feed into them. The Initiative offers a range of modern foreign languages and modes of delivery.



Funded by the Welsh Assembly Government for 3 years in its first phase.

Led by CILT Cymru – the National Centre for Languages in Wales.



What is the intention of the MFL initiative as a whole?

- To support schools that want to teach a foreign language at Key Stage 2.
- To gather an evidence base of how teaching and learning a foreign language at KS2 can complement and enrich the primary curriculum and benefit pupils when they move on to secondary school.

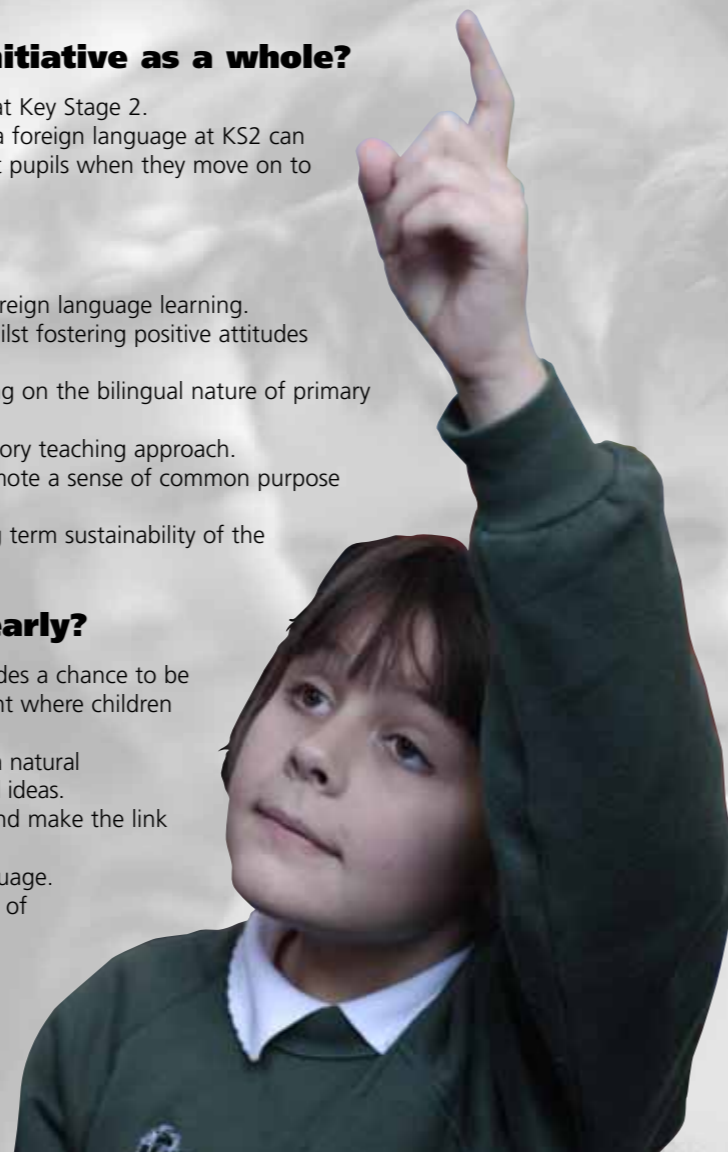
What are the aims of the Project?

- To give pupils an enjoyable and rewarding experience of foreign language learning.
- To encourage enthusiasm for languages at an early age whilst fostering positive attitudes towards other cultures.
- To develop pupils' language and literacy skills whilst building on the bilingual nature of primary schools in Wales.
- To motivate pupils of all abilities using an active, multi-sensory teaching approach.
- To foster effective primary-secondary cooperation and promote a sense of common purpose through the sharing of good practice.
- To develop the role of the class teacher with a view to long term sustainability of the Project.

Why is it good to start languages early?

- Language learning is a fun, stimulating experience. It provides a chance to be playful and uninhibited within a secure primary environment where children learn best.
- Children are keen and receptive at a young age. They have a natural curiosity and a greater capacity to absorb new language and ideas.
- It offers a new context in which to develop existing skills and make the link between languages.
- It improves long-term performance in any subsequent language.
- It reinforces a child's concept of grammar and small details of language – sounds, rhythms and intonation.
- Our economy needs linguists.

The Assembly Government and CILT Cymru are committed to supporting clusters to realise their own objectives and to learn from their experiences.

- Creu cronfa o dystiolaeth ynghylch sut y gall addysgu a dysgu iaith dramor yn CA2 gyflenwi a chyfoethogi'r cwricwlwm cynradd a bod o fantais i ddisgyblion pan fyddant yn symud ymlaen i ysgol uwchradd

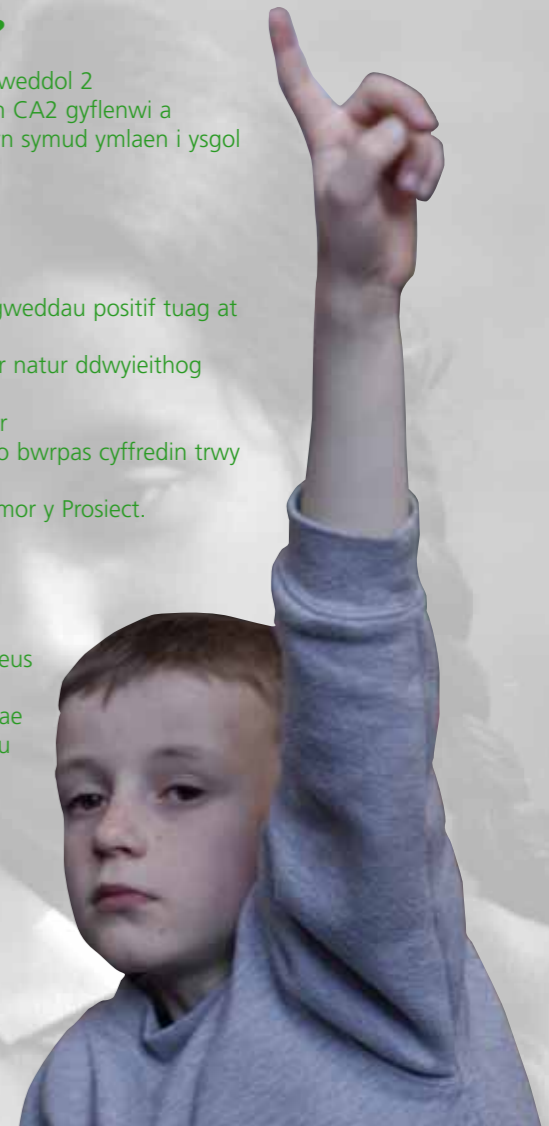
Beth yw amcanion y Prosiect?

- Gwneud dysgu ieithoedd tramor yn brofiad plaserus a buddiol i ddisgyblion
- Ennyn brwdfrydedd dros ieithoedd pan yn ifanc ac, ar yr un pryd, meithrin agweddau positif tuag at ddiwyllianau eraill
- Datblygu sgiliau iaith a llythrennedd y disgyblion ac, ar yr un pryd, adeiladu ar natur ddwyieithog ysgolion cynradd yng Nghymru
- Ysgogi disgyblion o bob gallu trwy ddefnyddio dulliau addysgu aml – synnwyr
- Meithrin cydweithrediad cynradd – uwchradd effeithiol a hyrwyddo synnwyr o bwrpas cyffredin trwy rannu arferion da
- Datblygu swyddogaeth yr athro dosbarth gyda golwg ar gynladwyedd hirdymor y Prosiect.

Pam mae'n dda i ddechrau dysgu ieithoedd yn gynnar?

- Mae dysgu ieithoedd yn hwyl ac yn ysgogol. Mae'n rhoi cyfle i fod yn chwareus a phenrhydd mewn amgylchedd cynradd diogel lle mae plant yn dysgu orau
- Mae plant ifanc yn awyddus i ddysgu ac yn barod i dderbyn gwybodaeth. Mae ganddynt chwilfrydedd naturiol a mwy o allu i amgyffred ieithoedd a syniadau newydd
- Mae'n cynnig cyd – destun newydd er mwyn datblygu sgiliau sy'n bodoli a gwneud y cysylltiad rhwng ieithoedd
- Mae'n gwella'r cyflawniad hirdymor mewn unrhyw iaith sy'n dilyn
- Mae'n atgyfnerthu syniad y plentyn o ramadeg a mân fanylion iaith – synau, rhythmau a chywair
- Mae angen ieithyddion ar ein heconomi.
